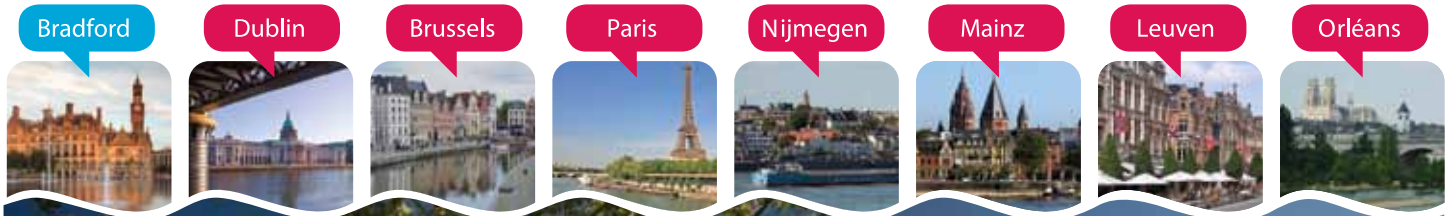


Facing Flood Risk Across Europe
