

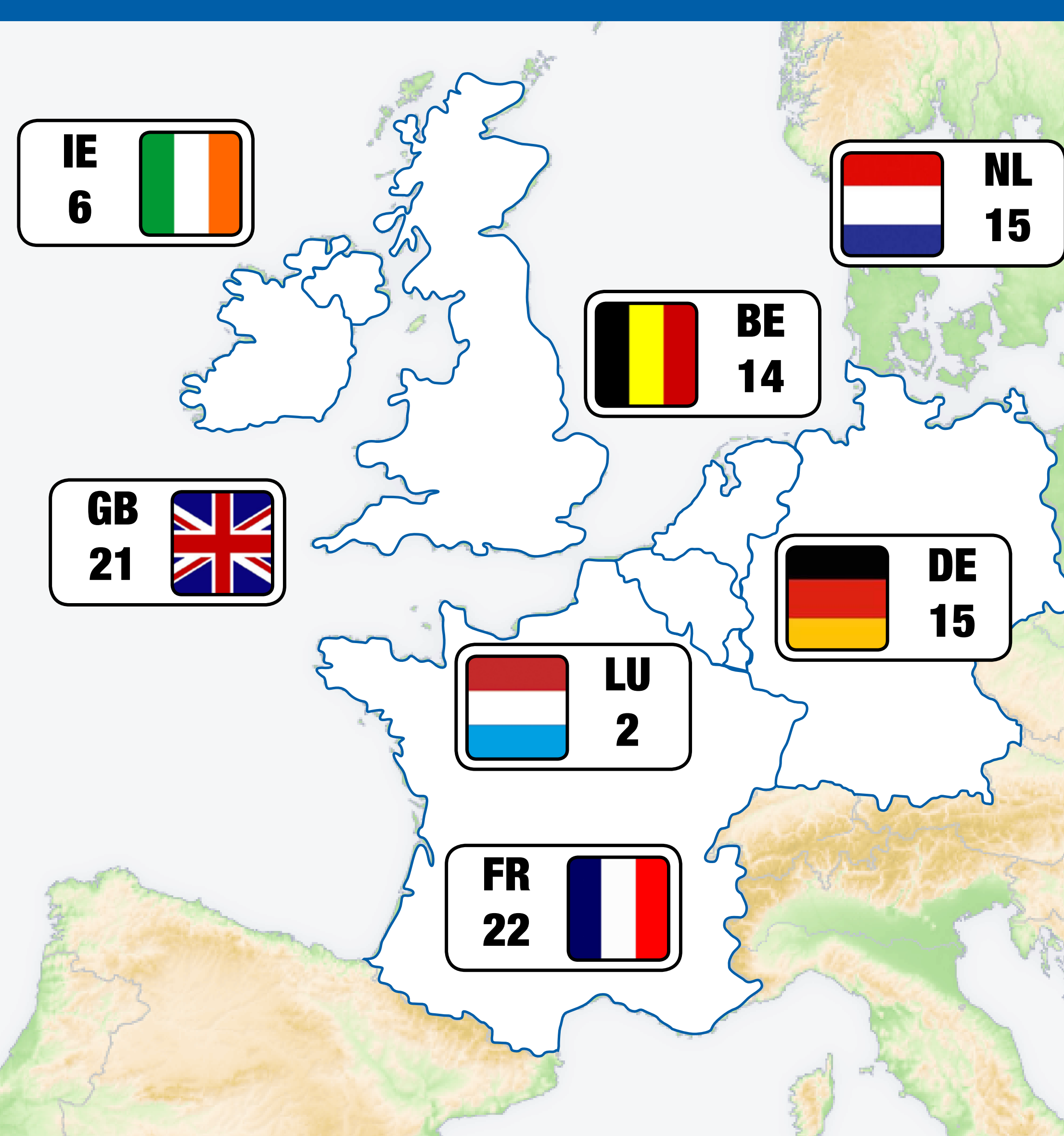


Adaptation to the Spatial Impacts of Climate Change
